Founded in 1890 and playing on one of the best bowling surfaces in Edinburgh, Braid Bowling Club is keen to attract new members. The season runs from the 3rd week in April to the end of September. In addition to the friendly ‘bounce’ games and the Monday and Friday ‘Hat Nights’, there is a busy programme of internal competitions and external League matches and ‘friendlies’ against other clubs. There is also a programme of activities run during the winter for club members and their friends.

New members can be assured of a warm welcome.

Coaching is available for beginners; bowls and bowling shoes can be provided.

Rather than the usual annual membership of £195, full membership for your first year is free.

There are free “taster sessions” most Sunday afternoons starting at 2.00pm from the first Sunday in May to the first Sunday in September. No previous experience is required. Bowls and shoes are available.
